SETTING THE AGENDA

PAYPAL PROCESS

Discussed what needs to be done to enhance the PayPal experience for members. HF SWITCHING OPPORTUNITY

Bruce updated us of opportunity per Ed N2II for the club to acquire an antenna switcher Hamplus AS-84E for very low investment. This means any radio can use any antenna and manages the conflicts simultaneously. From Hamplus the main control box is \$1400 and each radio control station is \$500 each for total of \$3400 vs less than \$1100 for the main control box and 4 antenna control stations. Biggest concern is to ensure robust training and protect our investment. We may roll training into new keying of shack access. We will need to resolve all issues with the HF stations are 100% resolved. Motion carried to purchase this equipment. Ralph asked what funds we need to run the origination and suggested we have a budget. Bruce said our total annual expense if about \$2500 per year. Jeff.R stated we need to build curriculum to train people on the use of this new equipment.
