

## SOUTH COUNTY NBEMS NET SCRIPT

As of July 30, 2017

Good Evening, this is **[your callsign]**, **[your name and location]** commencing the **[dd-mmm-2016]** session of the South County NBEMS Net. I will be your Net Control Station for this evenings Net. This Net is conducted for all radio amateurs that wish to learn or practice the techniques needed to pass information efficiently in a digital format. This Net is conducted in a mixed mode format which means that both digital message and analog voice communications are acceptable, and that you need not have NBEMS software to participate in the net.

This is a directed net, which means that stations must be invited to transmit by Net Control. At this time, if you haven't already done so, please start the **fldigi [3.23.07.21]** and **flmsg [2.0.12]** programs.

This Net convenes every **Monday** evening at **2000 Hours (8:00 PM** local time) on the **145.290 Boca Raton Amateur Radio Association Repeater, N4BRF**. The PL is **110.9**.

At this time we will take short of time stations. Please give us your **Call-Sign Phonetically** and **Name** followed by your **Location**. Short of time stations are welcome to leave the net at any time. Are there any short of time stations?

At this time we will take all other check-ins.

At this time we will send a test transmission to check that your NBEMS system is operating correctly.

Remember to identify yourself by **Call-Sign**, that you are about to transmit a NBEMS **message**, the **size**, and **length**. Also limit yourself to **less than 2KB or 2 minutes so as not to time-out the repeater**.

Someone is generally available a half an hour earlier to assist with technical questions and issues.
