MINUTES for 5-June-2018

The BRARA monthly association meeting was held at the West Boca Library. The meeting was called to order by President Bruce KO4XL at 7:10 PM. There were 32 members and 1 guest present. Bruce introduced the directors and members introduce themselves. New members shared likes and objectives.

Secretary's Report

Reported the LoTW issues and credits were resolved. Reported LoTW 3 new countries worked this month, 274 countries on DxCC, and 203 on phone, 234 on CW. Lot of 20m FT8 activity by club members (W2RT), 48 worked all states (WAS) and need WY and ND. Got 5 band worked all zones (WAZ), got us to 159 of 200 zones. 6M has been hopping last few weeks, worked a lot of Europe about 10am to 11.30am daily on FT8 on 50.313 MHz for North America and 50.323 MHz for Europe. May use 50.333 MHz if it's really overloaded. We received QSL cards such as Bangladesh.
