#### Disaster Comm

- \* FCC must justify services and frequency allocations
- \* Amateur service has five reasons for existence
  - > Enhance the radio art
  - Advance communications and technical skills
  - Expand number of trained operators, technicians, and electronic experts
  - Enhance international good will
  - PROVIDE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION

#### Past Lessons

- \* Hurricane Andrew Exposed our flaws
- \* Although neighboring agencies could help communications were an issue
- \* Protocols, 10-codes, phonetic alphabets were inconsistent across services
- \* Incident command was fragmented at all levels, each agency protecting its turf

# Changes

- \* Incident command system provides unity of command and defined command structure
- \* All agencies agreed to use the same phonetics and communication protocols
- \* Except for specific prowords all communications would be in plain language

## Phonetics

- \* ICAO word list (same as Amateur radio)
- \* Phonetics & Numbers have clearly defined pronunciations
  - \* 9 is niner
  - \* Ø is "zero" not "oh"
- \* Speak slowly and clearly

# Formal Message Traffic

- \* Similar to ham radio
- \* ALL formal traffic is logged
- \* Messages are prioritized
- \* Preamble, text, signature
- \* Message is tracked from origination to destination
